




MEET THE TEAM

SCREENING / RECRUITMENT

RESEARCH TEAMS AND SPEECH & LANGUAGE TEAMS SHOULD WORK TOGETHER TO IDENTIFY, SCREEN AND RECRUIT PATIENTS INTO THE STUDY AS EARLY INTO THE 4-31 DAY PERIOD AS POSSIBLE.

KEEP AN EYE ON PATIENTS WHO MAY BECOME ELIGIBLE, AND LET US KNOW OF ANY STUDIES THAT ARE IMPACTING RECRUITMENT SO WE CAN EXPLORE CO-ENROLMENT.

REMEMBER TO BOOK IN YOUR WORKING LUNCHES, THIS IS A GREAT OPPORTUNITY FOR THE TEAMS TO MEET ONE ANOTHER, AND DISCUSS HOW TO ENSURE THE SMOOTH RUNNING OF PHEAST LOCALLY!

FAQS

Q: PIF A PARTICIPANT HAS A VFS / FEES JUST BEFORE THE DAY 14 FOLLOW UP, CAN THE BLINDED SLT KNOW THE OUTCOME?

A: YES, BUT THIS INFO SHOULD BE COMMUNICATED VIA A VERBAL HANDOVER BY THE UNBLINDED SLT. Q: IF I HAVE RECEIVED PHAGENYX TRAINING, CAN I GO ON TO TRAIN ANOTHER STAFF MEMBER ON USE OF THE DEVICE?

A: NO - ALL DEVICE TRAINING MUST BE DELIVERED BY A PHAGENESIS REPRESENTATIVE. IF YOU HAVE ADDITIONAL TRAINING NEEDS PLEASE GET IN TOUCH WITH THE TRIAL TEAM.

Q: WHAT IF THE BLINDED ASSESSOR BECOMES UNBLINDED?

A: SEE IF THERE IS ANOTHER AVAILABLE BLINDED ASSESSOR TO DO THE BEDSIDE ASSESSMENT. IF NO ONE ELSE AVAILABLE, THE BEDSIDE ASSESSMENT CAN BE DONE BY AN UNBLINDED ASSESSOR BUT PLEASE NOTE THEY BECAME UNBLINDED AND REASON FOR BECOMING UNBLINDED.

Q: WHAT HAPPENS IF I CAN'T FIND AN INFORMANT FOR THE PARTICIPANT?

A: THE IQCODE (PART OF THE COGNITION SUB-STUDY) SHOULD NOT BE COMPLETED AND LEFT BLANK IN THE DATABASE.

BEST PRACTICE TIPS


PES TREATMENT SHOULD START ON THE SAME DAY AS RANDOMISATION, OR DAY AFTER IF NECESSARY ENSURE YOU HAVE ALL OF THE LATEST TRIAL DOCUMENTS - THERE IS A VERSION CONTROL TABLE ON THE PHEAST DOCUMENTS PAGE

PLEASE ENSURE DATA IS ENTERED INTO THE E-CRF IN A TIMELY MANNER, AS THE DATABASE IS CONTINUOUSLY MONITORED

CONTACT THE TRIAL TEAM IF YOU HAVE ANY ELIGIBILITY QUERIES (OR GENERAL QUERIES) - WE'RE MORE THAN HAPPY TO HELP!

ENSURE THE NAMES OF THE BLINDED ASSESSORS ARE RECORDED WITHIN THE E-CRF
