### NEW: electronic process for PI SAE review

Apologies we didn't mention this at the Investigator meeting at UKSF, this change was implemented by our programmer much quicker than we anticipated.

Following a sponsor review we have been asked to demonstrate how PI oversight is documented in TICH-3. Introducing this electronic system should simplify the need for PIs to print off SAE reviews, please see attached guidance for how to complete the very simple electronic review.

#### **OPTIONAL REVIEW OF OTHER eCRFs**

You will now see the dialogue box on all eCRFs (enrolment, day 7, death/discharge, protocol violations). The PI can review and document approval using the dialogue box but this is NOT REQUIRED on these eCRFs, <u>only the SAE</u> review by the local PI is required.
