### UKSF

### NEW: electronic process for PI SAE review

Apologies we didn't mention this at the Investigator meeting at UKSF, this change was implemented by our programmer much quicker than we anticipated.

Following a sponsor review we have been asked to demonstrate how PI oversight is documented in TICH-3. Introducing this electronic system should simplify the need for PIs to print off SAE reviews, please see attached guidance for how to complete the very simple electronic review.

### **OPTIONAL REVIEW OF OTHER eCRFs**

You will now see the dialogue box on all eCRFs (enrolment, day 7, death/discharge, protocol violations). The PI can review and document approval using the dialogue box but this is NOT REQUIRED on these eCRFs, only the SAE review by the local PI is required.
