STUDY WITHIN A TRIAL (SWAT)

Full ethical approval for the SWAT was received 31st March 2022. Sites will be randomised into either use of this animated video and/or standard consent processes. The intervention may improve understanding of all participants not just those in ethnic minority groups, we will therefore include all UK participants.

The video is available in English, Polish, Bengali, Punjabi and Urdu.
