





#### SMALL HAEMATOMA VOLUMES



We remind sites to estimate haematoma volume before enrolment, targeting patients most likely to benefit from haemostatic therapies. Whilst we specifically exclude patients with massive haematoma, we do not have a formal cut-off for minimal haematoma volume. A number of participants with very small haematoma (< 1ml), have turned out not to have ICH. If unsure, please check with the radiologist or treating physician to confirm that the patient has ICH and would benefit from a treatment aimed at preventing haematoma expansion.

#### STREAMLINED RECRUITMENT

**Remote consent** - As a reminder consent can be taken virtually by a delegated member of research team (code J) via telephone or telemedicine — so it is possible to enrol patients if you are not on site. This is then document in the patients' medical notes.
