## WITNESS FOR CONSENT

**Consent obtained in person does not require an independent witness.**

The independent doctor consent for enrolment is written consent and documented using the Professional Legal Representative short information sheet and consent form. In person, you as the investigator, sign as the person receiving consent.

**Consent obtained via telemedicine requires a second member of staff to witness that consent was indeed received.**

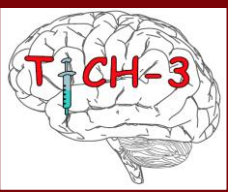
This includes relative consent and professional legal representative consent via an independent doctor. If you are confirming eligibility and receiving consent via telemedicine, a second member of staff also needs to witness this.

## REPORTING SAFETY OUTCOMES



All pre-specified **safety outcomes** are reported using the SAE CRF, even when the safety outcome does not prolong hospital admission/is not life-threatening etc.

If a participant unfortunately passes after day-7 but before discharge, please report their death on the Death/Discharge CRF and complete an SAE CRF.

If you do not have access to the cause of death or their medical notes at the time of reporting please let the TICH-3 team know, or complete the SAE CRF as 'not known' to be corrected at a later date.
