SA 04 22 - ENROLLING PATIENTS ON DOACS

Following approval of SA 04, patients with ICH taking Direct Oral Anticoagulants (DOAC) are now eligible for inclusion to the TICH-3 trial. Please note that TICH-3 IMP may be given in ADDITION to standard of care eg. Idarucizumab or PCC.

However, if your local guidelines recommend giving TXA for DOAC related ICH or you enrol patients into ANNEXA-4 then recruitment into TICH-3 is NOT permitted.
