TICH-3 has recruited a further 28 UK participants since the last newsletter, 13th July 2023, thank you so much for your continued support!

Please remember to send us through the destructions logs for the expired IMP if you haven't already done so.

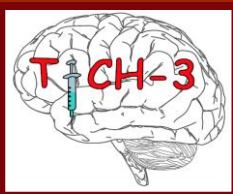

If you submit an SAE that is ongoing, please remember to update this SAE when the event is resolved.

If the patient dies, unless you think the death was related to this event please complete a data correction that this event was resolved and then submit a new SAE for the fatal event.

FOLLOW ON WRITTEN CONSENT

Please remember to obtain follow on written consent as soon as possible after the treatment has been administered and upload to the TICH-3 website.

Please remember that consent forms must be initialled and not ticked.

All details relating to obtaining consent must be documented in the patient's medical notes, including oral enrolment consent.
